Resolution No. 2021-01, Amending Resolution No. 2013-2 Regarding Fees for Copies of Records

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2013, the Town of Dakota Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 2013-2 Setting Fees for Copies of Records, as allowed under s. 19.35(3) Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, some of the costs set in that resolution are contrary to Wisconsin Attorney General opinion (72 Op. Atty. Gen. 150 (1983)); and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Towns Association attorneys have recommended that the Town of Dakota amend its fee schedule to be compliant with the Attorney General's advice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dakota Town Board that the fees for records be amended as follows (former language struck through, and new language bolded and underlined):

The following fees for satisfying records requests under s. 19.35, Wis. Stats., are established:

- a. Actual cost of reproduction & admin. (copy or scan):\$1.50 \$0.25 per page
- b. Actual cost of research of record (a.k.a. "location fees"): \$25.00 per request hour to locate the record, if it takes two or more hours
- c. Actual cost of shipping and mailing: Current postal rate

All other aspects of the Wisconsin State Statutes in this regard will be adhered to, including, but not limited to, the following:

- Requests costing \$5 or more to fulfill will require prepayment. (s. 19.35(3)(f), Wis. Stats.)
- The records custodian is not required to "create a new record by extracting information from existing records and compiling the information in a new format." (s. 19.35(1)(1))
- Reproductions of driver licenses and/or identification cards may not be released to requesters—even if redacted—per s. 343.43(f) and s. 343.50(12)(e), Wis. Stats.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will be in effect the day after posting per s. 60.80 (1)(c), Wis. Stats.
