

**MINUTES OF THE DAKOTA TOWN BOARD ROAD REVIEW
MAY 17, 2022**

CALL TO ORDER

The annual Dakota Town Board Road Review began at 5 p.m., with the vehicle leaving from the town hall parking lot. The remainder of the meeting took place on the road. All board members were present: Chairman Bobby Bandt, Supervisor Jeremy Kubasta, and Supervisor Gary Grenier. Clerk Melanie Stake was also in attendance to take minutes.

SPECIFIC ROADS

Czech Court: The portion of road east of State Road 22 needs resurfacing. This project is slated for 2023.

Hillside Street: Drainage continues to be an issue. In a few years, the board should consider extending the curb and gutter on the west side of the street.

Mielke Way Road: There are dead trees in the right-of-way near the “High Water” signs that need to be removed. Others need to be trimmed.

Pine View Drive & Boat Landing: The board may consider using American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to reconstruct the last 400 feet of Pine View and center it on the right-of-way. The boat landing also needs to be leveled off. Preparations for this should be discussed at the regular board meeting in June.

Southgate Terrace: Crack-filling should be done next year.

White River Trail: The end of the boat landing needs repairs, and tree cutting/trimming needs to be performed.

OTHER ROAD MATTERS

At many intersections, the inside corners of the road have deteriorated and need to be fixed/built up with gravel.

A “dry hydrant” is being proposed near the bridge on County Road JJ. Bandt will discuss this with Waushara County.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the vehicle returned to the town hall at 7:23 p.m., at which time Bandt adjourned the meeting.

These minutes are a draft, subject to approval or amendment at subsequent meetings of the town board. Any amendments made will be detailed in the minutes of the meeting at which the changes are proposed, and afterward these minutes will be reposted with the changes.
